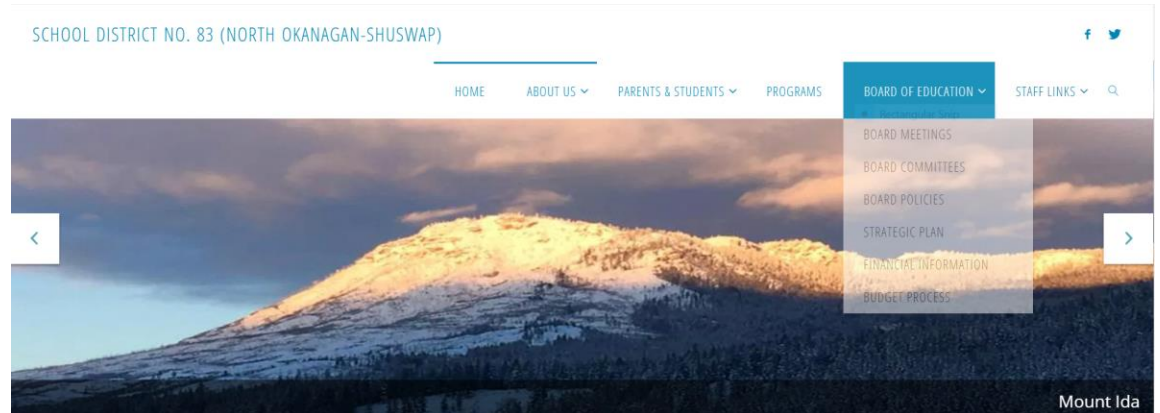

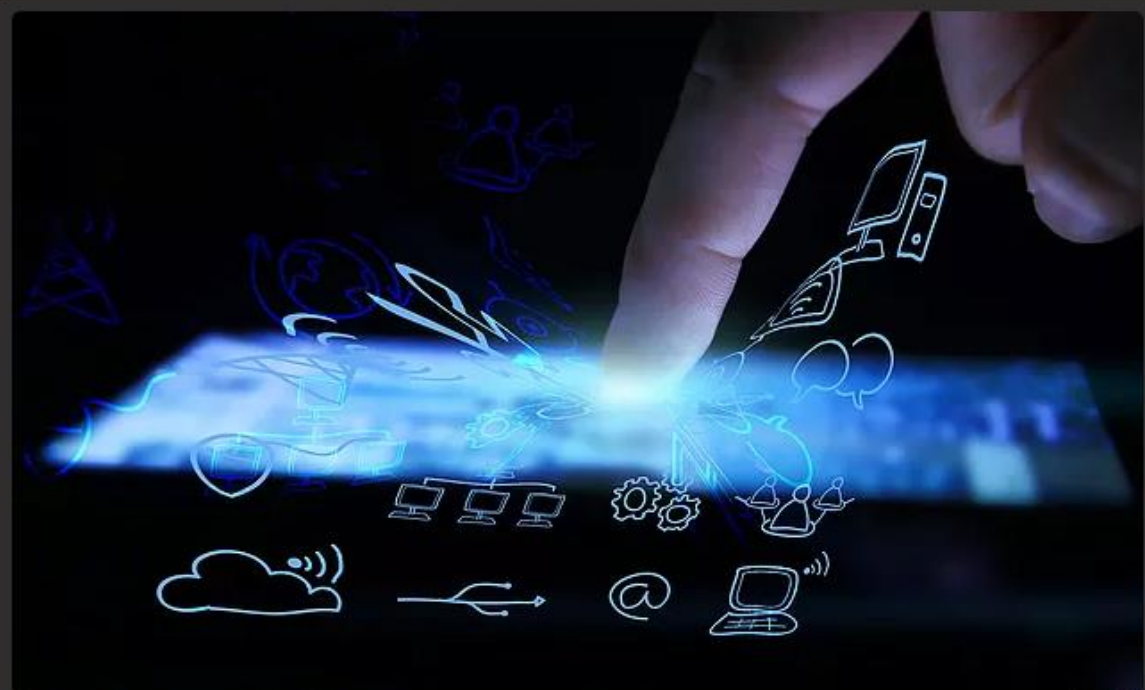

# Provincial SIS history

- An attempt was made in 2006 to move to all School Districts to a provincial SIS called BCeSIS
- BCeSIS drew media attention in September 2010 for slow performance that hampered the efforts of schools to make timetable changes, process student transfers, and complete attendance.
- With new school districts using the service, Fujitsu Service Desk was forced to limit the number of logins and post "BCeSIS unavailable" messages during peak usage hours.
- In September, 2011, the Ministry of Education decided to discontinue the use of the BCeSIS software, based on a recommendation from Gartner, Inc.
- The Minister of the day – George Abbot - said that the system had glitches but was still good value for money, and was being replaced largely because the technology was outdated.

- Ministry hosted "Discovery Workshops" with four remaining CIMS districts in the spring of 2018.

- MOU signed on October 28...but with an “escape clause”

- “Cost Recovery” info shared with Board at the In-Service on December 12

# PROS

- One Student / One Record
- Common system & standards
- Support from our peer districts (56 of 60)
- Provincial cross-enrolment
- Access to trained staff throughout the province
- Automatic data integration
- Consistent user interface
- We would avoid paying an annual penalty that could approach 1/2M

# CONS

- Performance concerns
  - Lost functionality (the gap is real)
  - Operating costs
  - Implementation costs
  - Loss of autonomy with an enterprise level SIS
  - Resistance to change
  - Onboarding of Saskatchewan
  - System unavailability
  - One year timeline

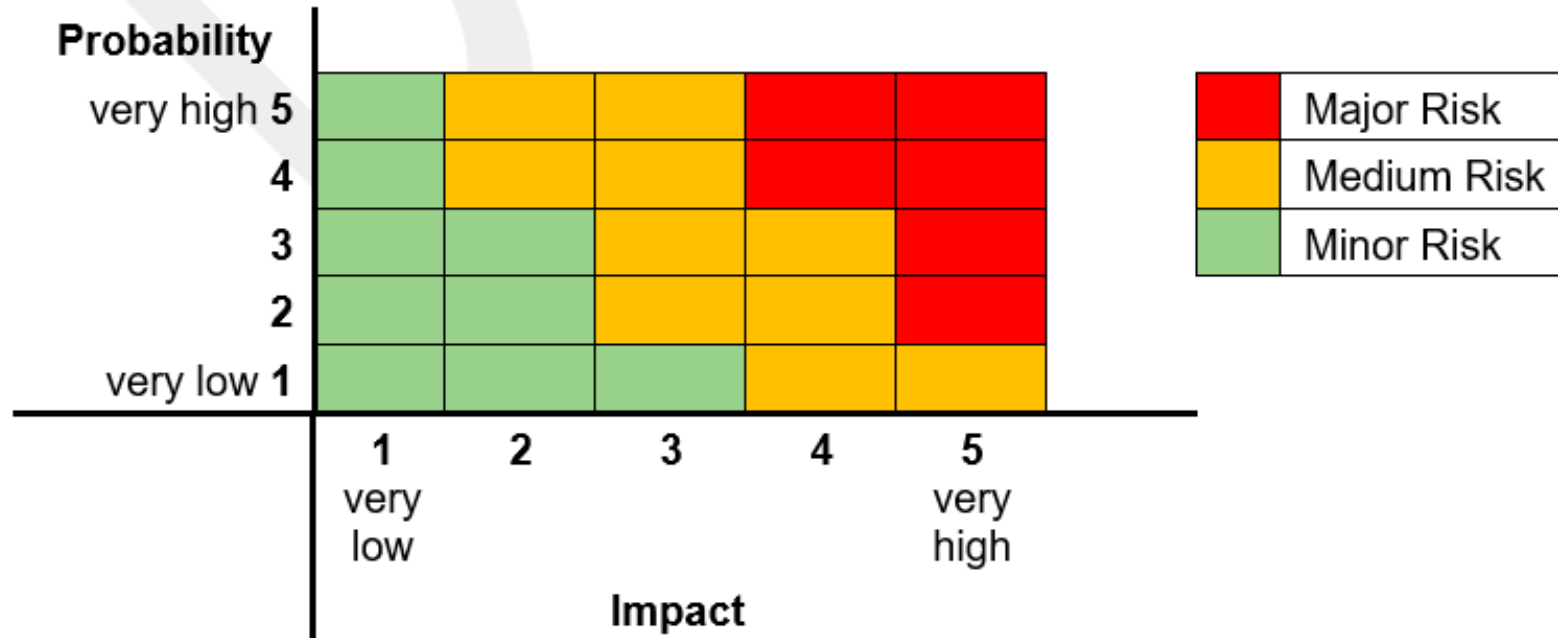
